

A little history...

Formerly known as the Drill Hall, the Centennial Hall was built in 1910, and by 1914 it housed local military activities. In 1920 the hall hosted the first Legion Meeting. Following a fire in 1960 the hall was remodeled and in 1967 it was re-named the Centennial Hall in honor of Canada's Centennial.

Today it plays host to several Local Weddings, Private Events, Exercise classes, School Performances & Plays, 4-H events, Dances, Dinners and Meetings in the upstairs Lion's Den.

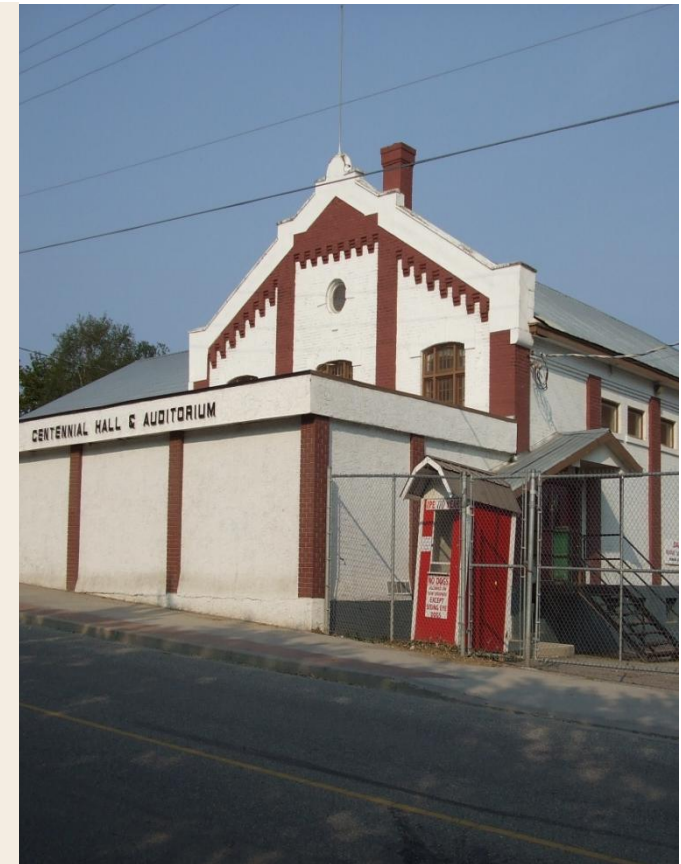

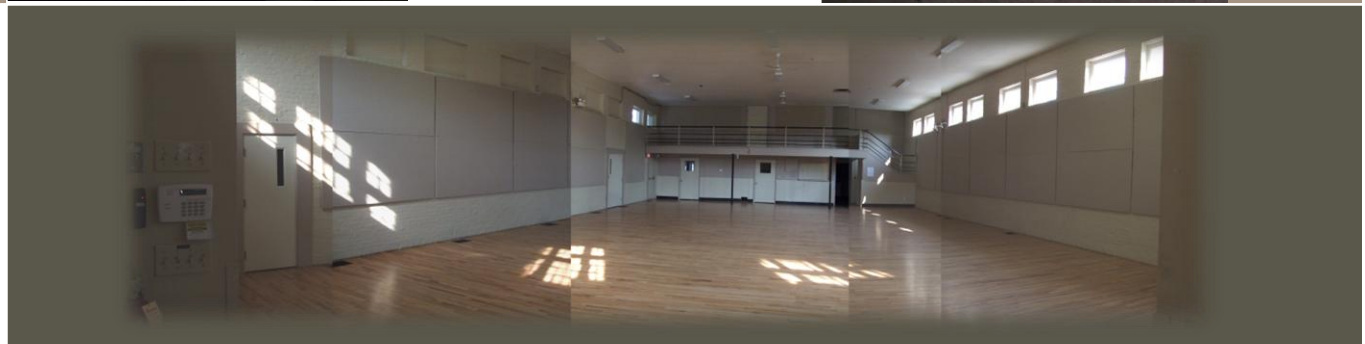
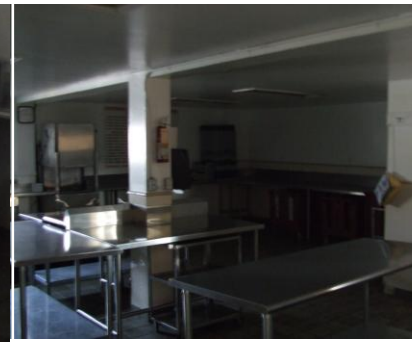
